BRICCO - Two Rivers Bordeaux Style 2005

Aromas of cassis, licorice, and dried plum are complimented with notes of cocoa, brown sugar and dark berry fruits while flavors of black cherry, blackberry, boysenberry and cassis dominate the pallet. This dark, inky wine exhibits firm acids which are supported by focused tannins, giving the impression of an intensely ripe wine with a lingering richness. Properly cellared, this wine should continue to develop over the next 5 to 10 years. **\$14.30**

CHÂTEAU JOUANIN - Côtes de Castillon 2005 - Bordeaux

Fresh, with berry and bark aromas and flavors. Medium-bodied, turning a bit chewy. **\$11.36**

CHATEAU LUCIÈRE - Bordeaux 2005

Fresh and full of ripe fruit with a velvety texture, this helps explain the raves about the excellent 2005 vintage. Great balance, silky tannin and real complexity make this wine a pleasure to drink young (not always the case in Bordeaux) and a great deal. **\$10.30**
