### **14 HANDS - Cabernet Sauvignon, Paterson Washington 2006**

A rich and flavorful, chock-full of black currant and dark cherry characteristics. The beautiful ruby color and medium to full body make this a great dinner companion. **\$10.50**

### **ARBOR CREST - Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley 2006**

Ripe and generous with tangy tannins playing against lively currant, blueberry and cedar flavors that linger on the finish. **\$17.00**

**BADGER MOUNTAIN - Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley 2007 (Organic) (No sulfites added)** Smooth and polished texture, with distinctive violet and plum flavors that echo on the soft finish. **\$13.00**

### **BEAULIEU VINEYARD - Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2005**

Loamy earth and dry leathery scents don't give the fruit flavors much of a chance. Tasted twice, with consistent notes. **\$17.00**

### **BEAULIEU VINEYARD - Cabernet Sauvignon Rutherford 2005**

Smooth and spicy, offering supple currant, black cherry, plum and hints of lavender. Delightful to drink now, with its supple tannins and complex range of flavors. **\$30.50**

### **BLACK STALLION – Cabernet Sauvignon**

This rich, smooth wine entices with fruity aromas of raspberry jam and plums and is nicely spiced with sarsaparilla, black pepper and chocolate notes. The temptations continue onto a full-bodied palate with refined dark fruit and cocoa flavors framed by ripe, silky tannins and a long finish. **Rutherford75%, Oak Knoll25%, Atlas Peak2%, Stags Leap District2% \$19.25**

### **CAMERON HUGHES LOT136 Cabernet Sauvignon – Napa Valley**

**Taste:** Black wine with a deep purple rim. Delicate French oak accompanied by blackberries and cassis illustrates the balance and sophistication expected of Central Napa. This blend of Rutherford and Oakville Cabernet personifies the classic Rutherford "dust" backed by a lush fruit, a hint of bright mint, and a resilient full body. **\$19.95**

### **GILSTRAP BROTHERS - Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley 2004**

Full bodied red wine, bold and distinctive, with a deep, dark cherry color. The bouquet initially hints of wood smoke, yielding to black cherry. On the palate, wonderful concentrations of orange and cherry flavors, rich and complex, result in a satin, long-lasting finish. **\$18.20**

### **GORDON BROTHERS – Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley 2005**

A supple style offers plenty of ripe cherry and currant fruit, shaded with hints of red pepper and cream. Lingers well against polished tannins. **\$18.20**

### **J. LOHR - Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles Hilltop Vineyard 2005**

A solid wine, with balanced cassis, plum, herb and mineral flavors on a medium frame, with muscular tannins and a lingering, black cherry- and tobacco-influenced finish. **\$30.00**

### **J. LOHR - Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles – Seven Oaks**

Rich and focused, with grapey currant, herb and vanilla bean oak flavors that are intense and persistent. **\$16.00**

### **JACOB'S CREEK – 2002 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon**

Rich ripe and still quite youthful fruit with blackberry, and blackcurrant plus plenty of spicy oak. **\$11.00**

### **NEAL FAMILY VINEYARDS - 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon**

This vintage has pronounced mountain fruit intensity. Complex aromas of dark fruit, spice and balanced oak notes were described in our production tasting as wonderfully mysterious. Deep dark black fruit. Very rich wine and brooding dark tones throughout. Some plum tones. Blackberry and cassis are the dominant flavors. Big and bold yet smooth and rich. Elegant wine. **\$40.00**

### **NEWTON - Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley Unfiltered 2005**

Dense and concentrated, touched by dry herb, mint and dried currant flavors that turn austere and tannic. **\$50.00**

### **NORTON CABERNET SAUVIGNON – 2003 Reserva!**

Very rich ruby red in color. Ripe and juicy, with liberal toast guiding the dark raspberry and boysenberry flavors. The finish lets the fruit hang on while a ganache note chimes in. Crowd pleaser. **\$12.50**

### **PATIT CREEK CELLARS – Cabernet Sauvignon 2005**

The '05 Cabernet Sauvignon presents red currant and black cherry flavors within earthy and light coffee characteristics. This Cab is a soft balanced and polished wine with a hint of chocolate at the finish. Northwest wine summit-gold award; long beach ca. ### **ROOT 1 - Cabernet Sauvignon Colchagua Valley**

High-toned Cabernet, with Bing cherry and red currant fruit backed by notes of vanilla and sweet dill. **\$11.20**

### **SAVIAH CELLARS - Cabernet Sauvignon, Walla Walla 2007**

2009 WINERY OF THE YEAR - Wine and Spirits Magazine. This wine has a rich, focused, distinctive and bracing, with a tight balance of firm tannins and juicy acidity to the gorgeous black cherry, currant and blackberry fruit. This doesn't lose an ounce of momentum as it courses through the long, expressive finish. 93 pts Wine Spectator (April 15, 2009) **\$29.75**

### **SEVEN HILLS – 06 Walla Walla Cabernet**

Intense dark red. Elegant fragrance of dust, marzipan, red plum, black currant, spice, licorice and dried herb. Polished, complex palate of red & black fruits, bitter almond, herb, black licorice and sweet spice. Smooth, bright, lengthy finish. **\$30.65**

### **SEVEN HILLS – 07 Klipsun Vineyards Cabernet**

Full red color. Nose opens to dust, pungent spice with vanillin, dried cranberry and cherry liqueur notes. On the palate warm, expansive, cherry jam with slight bandied fruit edge; hints of crème brulee and coffee. This is a riper style vintage Klipsun, but as is typical, will continue to open up and intensify dramatically in the next 12-18 months. Should age well for 10-12 years under proper cellar conditions. **\$32.00**

### **VITIS RIDGE - Cabernet Sauvignon, Wahluke Slope**

This fruit for this Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the Gilbert Vineyard, situated on the prestigious Wahluke Slope of Eastern Washington. The distinctive rich and peppery flavors of this wine showcase the unique soils and climate of this upcoming winegrowing region. The combination of low yields, meticulous vineyard management and late picking when the flavors are right create a bold and concentrated wine with a lush, lingering finish. **\$17.20**
