### OREGON

**AMITY** - 2007 ECO•WINE® Willamette Valley Pinot Noir (Organic) (No sulfites added)  
Our 2007 Eco-Wine® Pinot noir has a pleasant aroma of berries and red fruits, predominantly cherry and cranberry, with a hint of spice and vanilla. In the mouth it is smooth with a long pleasant finish. **\$20.00**

#### **Barron-Wahl 2007**

This wine begins with an intense fruit forward rush of dried cherry, red berry with currant undertones. The color is a deep, brilliant garnet, which is bright and clear. The mouth feel is round, soft and lush. The finish is almost the high point of this wine and it has a long lingering finish with soft chocolate notes. **\$20.00**

#### **BETHEL HEIGHTS – Willamette Valley 2008**

90 Points - "Bright ruby. Pungent, sexy scents of dried red fruits, star anise, allspice and rose. Lively and precise on entry, then gains flesh and breadth in the mid-palate, offering sweet raspberry and cherry compote flavors and showing no rough edges. The finish is juicy, seductively sweet and very long. A very impressive "basic" bottling that bodes well for the later-release single-site and reserve bottlings from this vintage."

#### **BLUE PIRATE PINOT NOIR 2008**

Vibrant red & black raspberries, wild strawberries, Bing cherries and floral (violet) aromas, with subtle notes of minerality and spice. Sweet, soft medium-weight entry, with dominant flavors of wild strawberry and raspberries echoing the aromatics. **\$13.50**

#### **BRICCO PINOT NOIR 2007**

A refreshing change from a string of warm, ripe vintages, this 2007 Pinot Noir offers elegant aromas of wild strawberry and red raspberry fruits, intertwined with beautiful floral nuances of rose petal and violets. The classic earthy notes of the Pommard clone combine well with hints of cinnamon and barrel spice. Supple tannins integrate with soft, but lingering acidity. **\$20.00**

#### **CHERRY HILL 2006 ESTATE Pinot Noir**

CHERRY HILL WINERY estate Pinot Noir is an elegant light delicate style of Pinot Noir. This beautiful wine was hand picked from our Pommard Clone and aged in neutral French oak for one year. This soft subtle Pinot Noir from the Willamette Valley will only improve with age, but she is a beauty right now. **\$17.75**

#### **COEUR DE TERRE - 2007 Pinot Noir**

Brilliant red color lures you in with signature Coeur de Terre earthy aromatics followed by notes of exotic spice, cherry, cola and butterscotch hints. Palette begins by hinting at the vibrancy with initial bright cherry and strawberry tones, followed by a deep layered texture of brambles, spice, minerals and smoky toast. **\$20.00**

#### **DAVID HILL PINOT NOIR - 2007 Estate**

It has a soft structured palate and flavors that linger amongst the finish. The oak seasoning and balanced fruit give this Pinot its structure and depth. The aromatic bouquet of spices and cherries, along with a well-rounded palate and ripe red fruit flavors, all combine to give this wine a proper finish. **\$14.00**

## PINOT NOIR WINE LIST

### **EMERSON PINOT NOIR - 2008**

A taste reveals a supple, caressing mouth feel with intense, layered flavors of black cherry, raspberry, strawberry, and plum. Subtle leafy earthiness and muted oak character play against food-friendly acidity and fine-grained tannins to round out the flavor profile. **\$17.20**

### **FIRESTEED - 2007 PINOT NOIR**

Vibrant cherry and sweet spice aromas jump out of the glass and the taste of the first round of summer raspberries and strawberries push the burst of fruit straight through to the surprisingly long finish. **\$13.95**

### **GIRARDET - Pinot Noir Umpqua Valley Barrel Select 2007**

A bit coarse, but flavorful with raspberry and tobacco flavors, lingering on the tight finish. **\$16.80**

### **IRIS VINEYARDS - 07 Pinot Noir**

The color is a beautiful deep garnet, and the nose bursts with aromas of black cherries and cola nut, with hints of saffras, black pepper, and clove. In the mouth this Pinot is ripe and jammy with intense ripe berry flavors, sweet oak spice and excellent concentration. The ripe finish is long and very smooth. **\$17.50**

### **J. DAAN WILLAMETTE VALLEY – 2007 PINOT NOIR**

Great value. More concentration than the '05, with notes of black cherry, strawberry, and good length with just a hint of oak peaking out. Just 400 cases produced. **\$16.50**

### **LA BÊTE PINOT NOIR – 2005 Meredith Mithchel**

From the highly acclaimed Meredith Mitchell vineyard in the hills southwest of McMinnville, our block sits on the spine of the ridge, adjacent to that of Ken Wright. Yields in this vineyard are typically very low (average under 2 tons per acre) and the skins are thick and well colored. Resulting wines are generally the most structured of our pinots. The 2005 vintage is just beginning to open up, and show its true potential and promises more years of aging potential. **\$22.50**

### **LA BÊTE PINOT NOIR – 2007 Croft Vineyard**

Our Croft vineyard pinot noir is elegant in aromas, with lots of cherry, open and approachable in the mouth, and has a bright finish. It is generally our earliest opening wine, and is just fun to drink!" **\$20.50**

### **LUMINOUS HILLS – Estate Grown 2009**

Polished and refined, an elegantly articulated range of cherry, raspberry, balsa and spice flavors coming together on the juicy, airy finish. **\$27.80**

### **MARKS RIDGE 2008 Pinot Noir**

Color: Deep Ruby. Nose: Raspberry and cherry, medium tannins with notes of black currant. Taste: Spice and Pepper, Touch of French oak and cherry tones. **\$20.00**

### **PRIMARIUS Pinot Noir – 2009**

Burgundian in style, layers of subtle dried fruit and spice that evolve on the palate. **\$15.00**

### **PUDDING RIVER - 06 Estate Pinot**

With an initial aroma of earth and spice leading to a dark and rich black fruit mid-palate this wine is very representative of the 2006 vintage. It is full bodied with a refreshing acidity that leads to a finish of firm tannins. **\$26.50**

### **RASCAL 07 Pinot Noir - NV**

Aromas of tart, red cherries. A bit of briary raspberry as well. It definitely smells like Pinot Noir. So far so good. Big time acidity. Really juicy stuff this Rascal. **\$8.50**

### **SEVEN OF HEARTS 2008 Pinot Noir**

Cinnamon clove spice beneath lots of violet. Rather fine and graceful aromas. Nice movement and polish in the mouth. Quite airy. Gains depth and substance, especially acidity. Finishes with touch of sweet, dusty herbs. Nice length and material. **\$20.00**

### **St. INNOCENT 2007 Pinot Noir, Zenith Vineyard**

This Pinot noir complements sweet meat entrees - grilled salmon, lamb chops, and filet. When served young, this wine is best if allowed to breathe for 1-2 hours. It is drinkable at release or will benefit from aging up to 5 years. **\$22.00**

### **TWIN FIR VINEYARDS 2007 Pinot Noir**

Twin Fir Vineyards 2007 Pinot Noir is a delicate fruit forward wine with luscious layers of ripe berry and cherry balanced with lively acidity, a kiss of warm spice and a hint of French Oak. **\$15.00**

### **WILDAIRE PINOT NOIR – 2008**

Perpetual aromas of red licorice, roses, violets, and bramble, mix with spice and toasty oak. The entry is very lavish, with a fine grained mid palate and flavors throughout that include rainier cherry, caramel, and vanilla. The medium length of the finish and the overall balance enable this wine to be paired with a variety of meals. **\$18.75**

### **WILLAMETTE VALLEY VINEYARDS – 2008 WHOLE CLUSTER FERMENTED PINOT NOIR**

As refreshing as liquid fruit salad in a glass, this wine opens with explosive aromas of wild strawberry, raspberry, black cherry, and a hint of smoke and anise. Flavors mirror the aromas and are complemented by balanced, soft tannins and ripe acidity. Juicy flavors lead to a juicy pomegranate finish. This wine holds an elegant, refined weight on the palate throughout, inviting another sip. **\$19.90**

### **WILLAMETTE VALLEY VINEYARDS – 2007 FOUNDERS RESERVE PINOT NOIR**

The 2007 Pinot Noir has sweet, delicate aromas of raspberries and red cherries with hints of cocoa and toast. The sweet and tart flavors of ripe, red cherries and raspberries are accented by hints of vanilla and white pepper spice. An elegant Pinot Noir with delicate round tannins and nicely-balanced acidity that lingers into the silky finish. **\$19.95**
