

TEMPRANILLO WINE LIST

CHATEAU LORANE - 2004 Tempranillo

This wine exhibits Bing cherry and marzipan nose, with hints of raspberry and oak. Medium to full bodied, it has balanced acidity and firm tannins. Enjoy its long lingering finish. Spent 15 months in 28% new American oak. **\$16.00**

REALEZA – 2004 Tempranillo Viño de la Tierra de Castilla y León

This supple red shows pretty berry and cherry fruit that's slightly candied, with bright acidity and light tannins. **\$8.75**

SPANISH SONS - 2007 Tempranillo

Spanish Sons Tempranillo is dry-farmed on old vines that average over 50 years in age. Approximately half of the fruit is grown on historic bush vines that were planted 50–120 years ago in 10' by 10' grids — the widest in the world. These vines yield complex fruit with soft, luscious tannins and signature notes of violets. The remaining grapes come from trellised vineyards, which were planted 20–30 years ago as a pioneering endeavor by Manuel Fariña. Planted and grown to maximum ripening, these vines produce tiny grapes of exquisite quality which contribute concentrated fruit flavors and deep, rich color to the wine. **\$13.05**

TAPEÑA – 2007 Tempranillo

This delicious wine captures the sometimes elusive character of Tempranillo - luscious red cherry fruit wrapped around an earthy, intense center. The finish is long and layered with a hint of coffee and chocolate and a pinch of spice. This distinctive wine from the heartland of Spain is unlike any of the top three red varietals so utterly available from all over the world. **\$7.95**
